The Art of building in North Queensland is an interactive exhibition that explores the domestic architecture of the North over the last 150 years. The exhibition also addresses issues of environmental sustainability and the role that contemporary architecture and building processes have in providing efficient "signature buildings" for future populations in tropical North Queensland.
