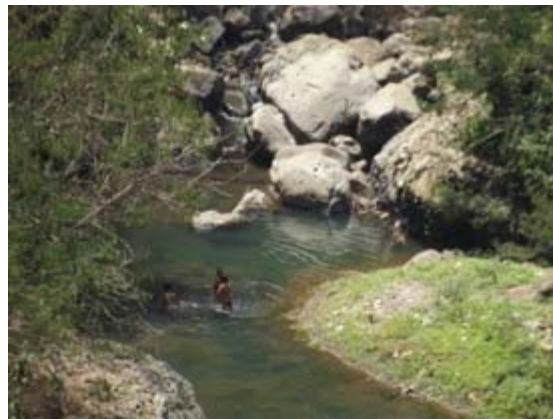

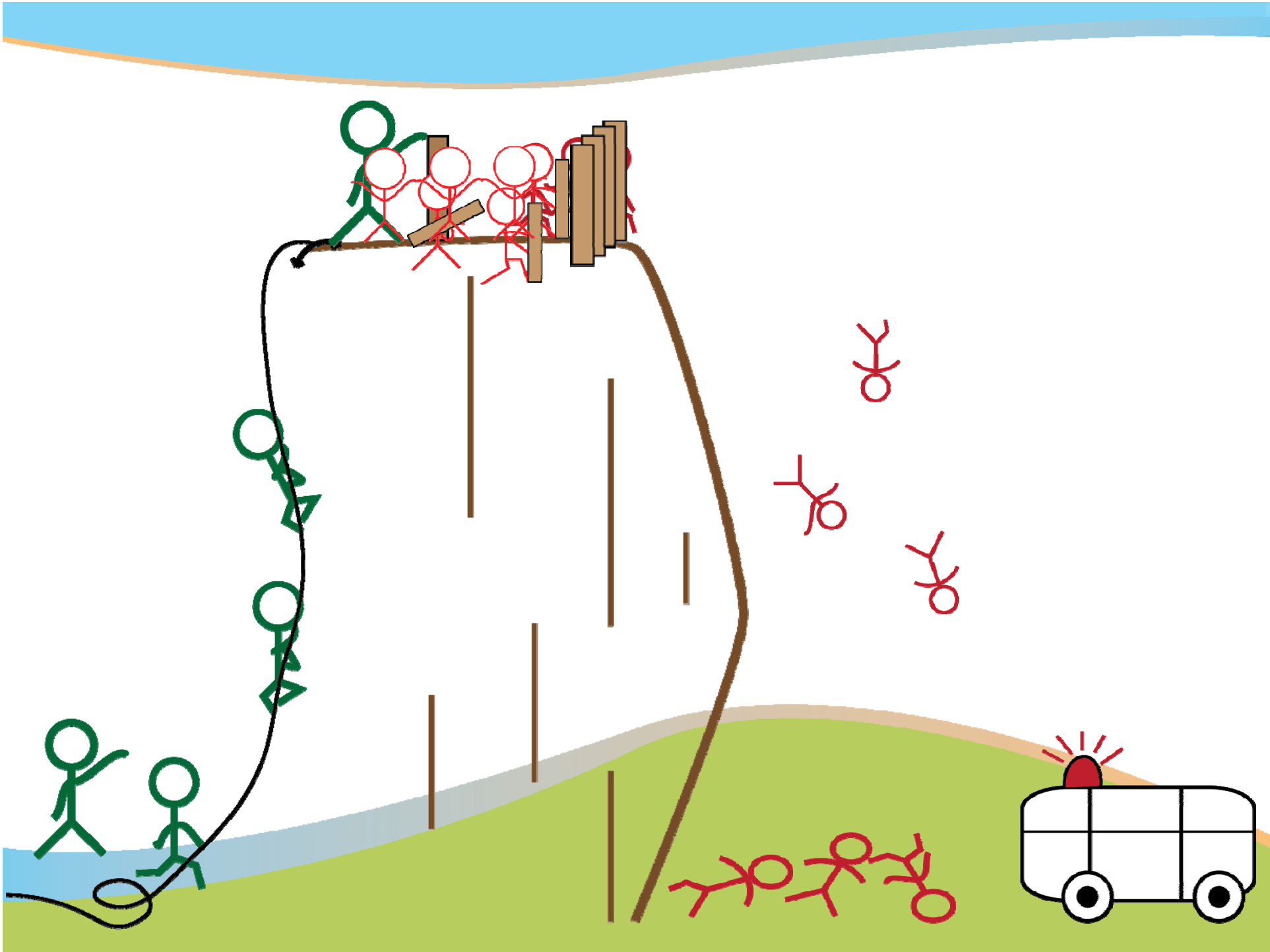

GOALS

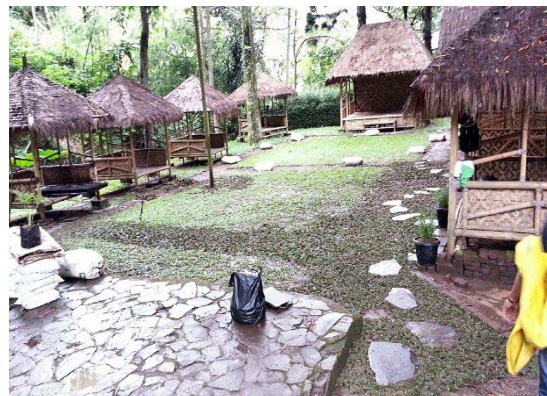
1. Spreading goodness and the spirit of sharing

ELC Education Program

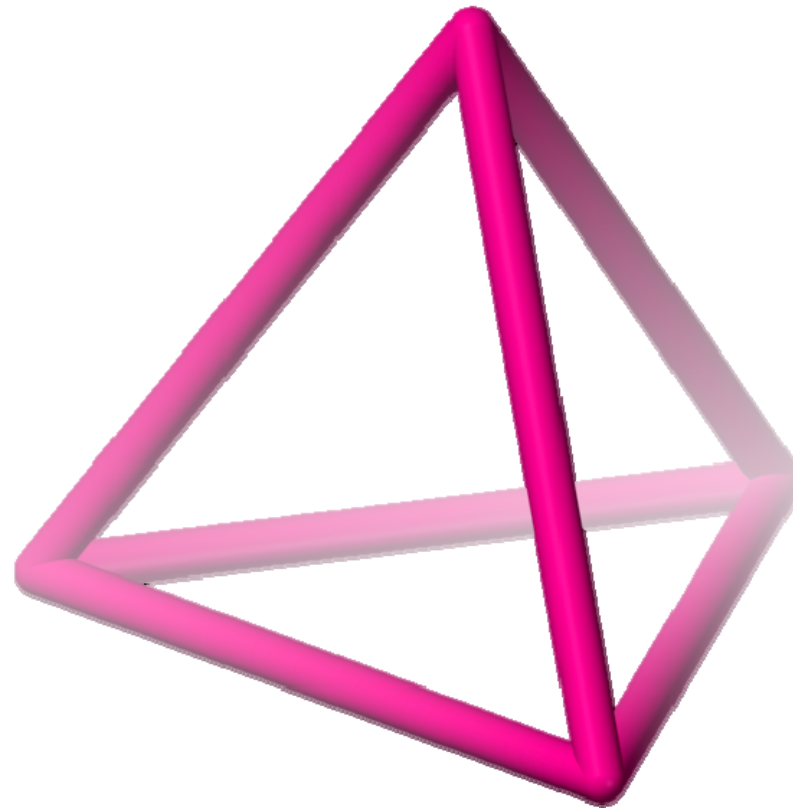

Culture : interaction and cooperation among human beings toward a better society

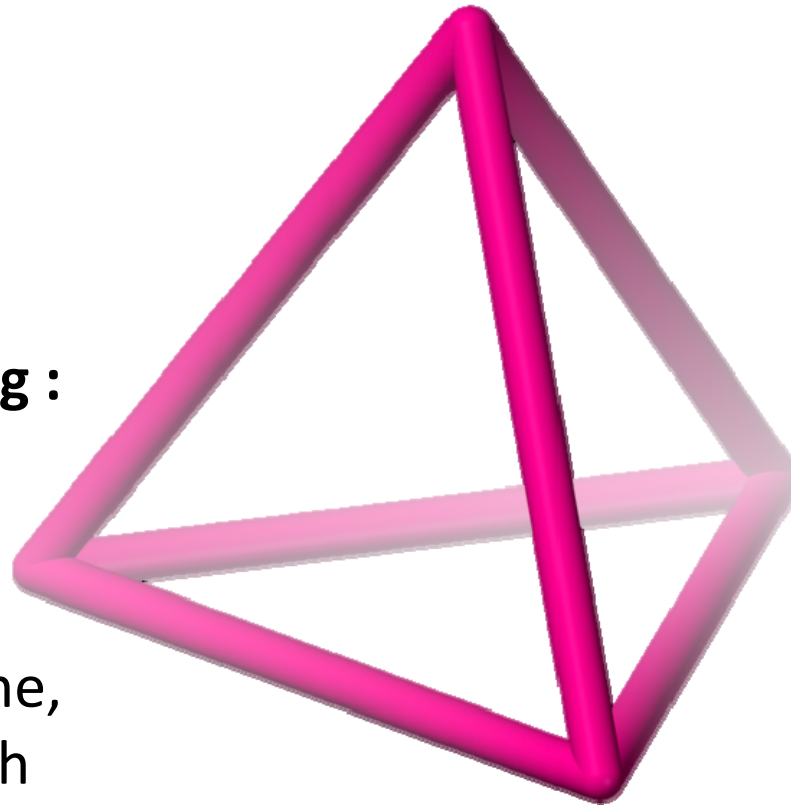


ELC Values
