Brolga Lakes is a leading edge sustainable, master planned development located adjacent to the Bruce Highway in Burpengary, half way between Brisbane and the Sunshine Coast.

Brolga Lakes has been granted a Bio-Diversity Offset Agreement from the State of Queensland and is now awaiting development approval from MBRC for the first stage of its unique master planned community. As sustainability is the guiding principle of this development, it is crucial that our built form conforms to these principles... As such, we are hosting an information workshop for interested professionals (designers, builders and architects), to discuss design/building partnerships going forward.

The event will feature a tour of the development site and a presentation and workshop session with refreshments on offer at the close of the workshop. We expect the formal part of the afternoon to conclude around 4.30pm.

The intent is to arrive at a preferred list of Architects/Designers/Builders with appropriate credentials in sustainable design with whom we will build an alliance into the future. When we go to market with Brolga Lakes the "preferred list" will be marketed to prospective buyers. To gain entry to our preferred list an organisation must have attended one of these workshops at Brolga Lakes. We expect to conduct one other around November this year.

People selecting a design from one of our preferred design team will have a relatively easy experience through our covenant approval process. People electing not to use a member of our preferred team will have their designs intensely reviewed under the covenant and may have additional inspections imposed during the construction stage.

Brolga Lakes will be seeking accreditation as an Enviro-Development project and from all independent assessments is expected to achieve national and international recognition.
