



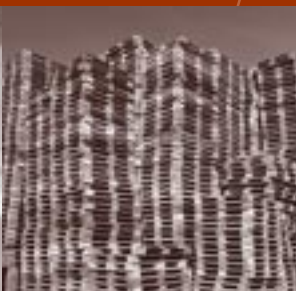

King County promotes job-site recycling through its Construction Works Program. Green Building is promoted through industry education of recognized green rating systems. For home building, the BUILTGREEN™ Program was developed locally and launched in 2000. For commercial building, King County sponsors training through the nationally recognized LEED™ (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) program.

### DEFINITION OF TERMS

- **CDL:** The acronym CDL will be used throughout this guide. It stands for Construction, Demolition and Landclearing material generated at job-sites.
- **Construction material:** Wood, concrete, drywall, masonry, roofing, siding, structural metal, wire, insulation and other building materials found at construction sites.
- **Demolition material:** Concrete, asphalt, drywall, carpet, wood, masonry, roofing, siding, structural metal, wire, insulation and other materials found in demolished buildings, roads and other structures.
- **Landclearing material:** Natural vegetation and minerals such as stumps, brush, blackberry vines, tree branches, associated dirt and sand, tree bark, sod and rocks.
- **Source-separated:** CDL materials that are separated from other waste and intended for recycling.
- **Co-mingled CDL materials:** Contains mixed recyclable CDL material that has not been separated.

### HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY

This directory has listings by geographical area for quick reference.

- The North area covers the area north of Lake Washington and into Snohomish County.
- The East area covers the area east of Lake Washington to the County line.
- The South area covers the area south of Lake Washington and south of the Seattle City limits.
- The West area covers the City of Seattle and the area west of Lake Washington.

# SETTING UP A JOB-SITE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Rising landfill fees have made disposal of construction, demolition and landclearing waste a significant expense. Reducing the amount of material going for disposal lowers the cost of doing business.

## IDENTIFY RECYCLABLES

Asphalt, concrete, cardboard, drywall, metals and wood are easy to recycle in King County. Recycling options also exist for asphalt roofing, fluorescent lighting, carpet, and carpet padding, ceiling tiles, and film plastic. Don't forget to set up recycling for beverage containers and paper from the job shack.

## CHOOSE A RECYCLING METHOD:

There are three basic approaches to job-site recycling:

- **Contract with a recycling hauler who accepts co-mingled CDL materials.** This service allows contractors to put multiple recyclables such as wood, cardboard and metals in one container. The recycling company takes the materials to a sorting facility where the materials are separated for recycling. Materials not accepted in co-mingled loads will still need to be source-separated.
- **Separate recyclables at the source for recycling.** This method involves collecting recyclables in separate containers as they are generated. The recycling hauler takes the materials directly to a recycler or a transfer site. Materials not accepted in co-mingled recycling, such as carpet or ceiling-tile, must be source-separated for recycling.
- **Self-haul your recyclables.** Source-separate recyclables in piles or containers on-site and haul them yourself to local recyclers or transfer sites. You may be able to drop off co-mingled loads at a recycling company. Call to confirm.

## SELECT A RECYCLER

Specify in an agreement with the recycling service provider:

- What materials will be recycled
- Requirement that weight or volume of recyclables be documented
- Requirement that material will go to a properly permitted facility
- Costs associated with the service (fees for container rental, hauling, recycling charges)
- Schedule for picking up containers
- How containers will be labeled

## INVOLVE SUBCONTRACTORS

- Include language in sub-contractor agreements that they will recycle
- Discuss the recycling program at every safety meeting or other regular meetings

## MONITOR THE PROGRAM

- Check dumpsters regularly to make sure material is getting separated properly

## DETERMINE SAVINGS

- Calculate the cost savings from recycling versus disposal using documentation from your hauler

# NEW CONSTRUCTION WORKS MEMBER PROFILES

## TIMBERLAND CUSTOM HOMES

### Waste Prevention Defines Builder's Process

Along with the more common waste prevention techniques of designing with standard dimensions and working with suppliers to reduce packaging, this custom homebuilder offers a unique perspective on waste prevention. Since these custom homes are built in modules at their Auburn facility, Timberland Custom Homes are constructed with minimal waste. Centralized construction and volume purchasing of materials and supplies keeps waste controlled, limits shipping and on-site construction waste, and reduces the impact of transportation.



The materials not reduced through their effective and conscientious manufacturing process are recycled. Timberland Custom Homes maintains an impressive 74% recycling rate, including recycling drywall, asphalt shingles, and carpet padding.

To complete their commitment to waste prevention, Timberland Custom Homes "closes the loop" on recycling by specifying recycled-content materials and products. New gypsum wallboard, carpet padding, and carpet used inside these modular homes all contain recycled or reclaimed materials. Outside, asphalt roofing and decking materials also contain reclaimed materials. These products meet the rigorous quality standards Timberland Custom Homes demands for their clients.

## WOODINVILLE LUMBER

### Constructing the Framework for Waste Prevention

Woodinville Lumber specializes in wood frame construction: trusses, wall panels, turnkey framing, and complete framing packages for approximately 700 single family homes each year. Over the years, this pioneering lumber company has made a commitment to waste prevention by purchasing customized equipment that maximizes lumber and minimizes waste. For example:

- Barge board, soffits, lookout materials, and floor joists are pre-cut using a computerized Optimizer Saw resulting in a significant reduction in overall wood waste.
- Wood fireplaces and floor panels are pre-built at their facility to reduce on-site waste for their customers.
- They also use 2x3s in place of 2x4s whenever possible to reduce waste and material consumption.

Even under optimal conditions, waste is generated, but at Woodinville Lumber waste wood, metals, and cardboard/packaging are recycled at a reported rate of 74%!



Closing the loop for this company means purchasing engineered wood products including finger-jointed studs, LVL laminated I-Beams, J-Joists, and Oriented Strand Board. They also specify metal truss plates manufactured from reclaimed metals.

Extending their waste prevention commitment beyond the boundaries of Woodinville Lumber, this industry leader engages suppliers as well as all staff personnel to create new opportunities for preventing waste. For their customers, Woodinville Lumber offers seminars on truss and prefabricated wall construction to help builders learn how to reduce on-site waste. This customer service translates into savings for builders and avoided disposal costs.

## QUADRANT HOMES

### Commitment to Excellence

With five active developments under construction in King County, Quadrant Homes has the potential to generate over 3,000 tons of waste material a month. But thanks to a comprehensive and aggressive recycling program, only a portion of that waste is being landfilled. Collectively, these five developments are recycling an average of 70%. And, what's good for the environment is good for the builder's bottom line: If all the material set aside for recycling was disposed, it could cost an additional \$158,000 per month.

The Most For Your Money

To further prevent waste, Quadrant Homes uses pre-cut trim, centralized wood cutting operations, standard dimensions for the homes, and reused formwork. They relocate landscaping and chip wood waste for reuse during site preparation. They also ask suppliers to deliver materials in reusable containers.

Quadrant Homes' commitment to sustainable construction is as comprehensive and aggressive as their successful recycling program. Quadrant Homes is a founding member of the Master Builders Association of King and Snohomish Counties' BUILTGREEN™ program. ## BAUGH CONSTRUCTION

### No Limit to Waste Prevention on Tight Downtown Site

Already known for its excellent work on recycling, Baugh Construction Company outdid themselves on the Metropolitan Park Project on Howell Street. On a tight downtown site, Baugh constructed an 11-story high-rise office building and parking garage and achieved a 77% recycling rate. Even more impressive, they implemented an array of creative waste prevention tactics.

Several strategies were key to achieving the 77% recycling rate:

- Use of the EcoPan service for recycling concrete spillage, a strategy that also helps in stormwater management;
- Grinding and reuse of 40,000 sq. ft. (1199 tons) of concrete and asphalt from demolition as backfill;
- Working with the City to test street-use permit fee programs that would encourage recycling.



What makes this project notable however, are Baugh's efforts to prevent waste. For example, they transplanted twenty 15 ft. red oak and maple trees to an off-site location, cared for them through the duration of the job, then re-planted them when the new sidewalk planters were in place. As a creative reuse of Styrofoam peanuts, they also filled the planters on the roof atrium with two feet of peanuts to reduce the overall weight of the planter.

Baugh's inventive approaches to recycling and preventing waste on this project demonstrate their commitment to protecting the environment by reducing, reusing, and recycling.

## CDL ACCEPTANCE POLICY AT KING COUNTY TRANSFER STATION FACILITIES:

King County owned and operated transfer facilities do not accept commercial CDL wastes. Exemption is provided for private vehicles licensed for 8,000 pounds (standard pick-up truck) or less. Small amounts of CDL that are part of a large load of municipal solid waste will also be accepted. Materials may not be longer than eight feet. Bulky items, such as concrete blocks, must be no greater than two feet by two feet in size and weigh less than 200 pounds. If pulling a trailer, total length from bumper to bumper should not exceed 25 feet. For more information regarding the solid waste acceptance policy at King County Transfer Stations, call (206) 296-4466.

## REPORT ILLEGAL DUMPING

Illegal dumping is a serious and persistent problem in King County. Each year tons of construction debris (wood waste, roofing, concrete), landclearing, and yard waste are dumped into forests, streams, ravines, and empty lots. The dumped material causes erosion, contaminates wells, water tables, and surface waters, attracts pests, creates fire hazards, and detracts from the beauty of our natural areas. In addition, cleanup and disposal of illegally dumped material cost taxpayers in Washington State hundreds of thousands of dollars each year.

## DEMOLITION

All demolition performed in King County requires a permit from the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency: (206) 343-8800. Demolition performed in unincorporated areas of King County also requires a permit from the Department of Development and Environmental Services: (206) 296-6600. Prior to demolition in the City of Seattle, call the Department of Construction and Land Use at (206) 684-8850.

## IS YOUR PROJECT CERTIFIED?

Certified green that is. Over the last few years a number of organizations have developed green building certifications or rating systems for both residential and commercial construction. Locally, two systems are available: Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED™) for commercial projects and BUILTGREEN™ for residential developments, multifamily, single family and remodeling. These two programs certify as “green” buildings that incorporate a number of building strategies that conserve resources and protect the environment.

These systems provide an important market-based tool for measuring the “greenness” of a building project and are rapidly becoming the standard by which a building’s environmental performance is measured. If you haven’t heard about them yet, you will soon. Developers are interested in using these systems to market their projects and make a positive impression while consumers want to buy homes or rent office space that is kinder to the environment. Your clients may ask you to consider these systems or simply require you to use them.

## LEADERSHIP IN ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN (LEED™)

The US Green Building Council offers this national rating system, which certifies projects as LEED™ Certified, Silver, Gold, or Platinum based on the number of points achieved. The points are available in five different areas:

- Sustainable Sites
- Water Efficiency
- Energy and Atmosphere
- Materials and Resources
- Indoor Environmental Quality



Certification is currently available for commercial projects. The U.S. Green Building Council is also developing a residential program, one for commercial interiors and one for operations. The City of Seattle now requires all their capital projects over 5,000 square feet to build to the Silver LEED™ level, and is encouraging the private sector build to similar standards through a pilot incentive program ([www.cityofseattle.net/light/conserve/sustainability/leed](http://www.cityofseattle.net/light/conserve/sustainability/leed)).
